FUNDING ALLOCATION

DEMOLITION/CLEARANCE PROGRAM: \$88,000

A program to demolish vacant, substandard structures and clear property lots that pose a risk to health and safety.

PARK IMPROVEMENT: \$144,985

A program to fund projects in parks within low- and moderate-income target areas and improve ADA accessibility in parks throughout the city of Sherman, promoting general health and wellness among the entire community. Focus will especially be to benefit those living in low-moderate income areas and those with disabilities.

PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION: \$ 75,746

The City proposes to use the Administration funds for personnel and support for all phases of the application process, environmental reviews, fair labor standard compliance, contract management, fair housing Grantee Performance Report, and preparation of annual Action Plan, Performance Report associated with the City of Sherman Five-Year Consolidated Plan and Strategy, and the producing of the 10-year Fair Housing Study.

HABITAT FOR HUMANITY: \$15,000

A program to provide external repairs to owner-occupied homes belonging to low- and moderate-income Sherman residents.

PUBLIC SERVICE ACTIVITIES: \$55,000

BOYS & GIRLS CLUB OF SHERMAN, INC.: \$5,000

Funds to be used to assist with the development and advancement of a teen program for those from low- and moderate-income households.

CASA OF GRAYSON COUNTY: \$3,500

A program to train and support volunteer advocates and staff on process and procedures to advocate for foster children in Grayson County that have been abused or neglected.

CHILD & FAMILY GUIDANCE CENTER OF TEXOMA: \$5,000

A program to provide counseling services for family dysfunction, alcohol and substance abuse, domestic violence, and sexual abuse for low- and moderate-income Sherman residents.

CHILDREN'S ADVOCACY CENTER: \$5,000

A program to provide high quality services to abused and traumatized children who, at one time, resided within the city limits of Sherman.

FOUR RIVERS OUTREACH: \$5,000

A program that serves those who are overcoming their struggles with addiction by providing a men's residential 16-bed facility and a 12-month Life Renewal program. Recipients are those who, at one time, resided within the city limits of Sherman.

GRAND CENTRAL STATION: \$5,000

A program to support nutrition, specifically food for low- and moderate-income Sherman residents.

GRAYSON COUNTY CRISIS CENTER: \$10,000

A program of activities that will provide emergency assistance to homeless women and children of domestic violence who, at one time, resided within the city limits of Sherman.

SHERMAN HOUSING AUTHORITY: \$8,000

A program to address the problems of drug abuse and associated crime in public housing. Activities include increasing law enforcement services to stop the sale of illegal drugs in and around assisted housing, apprehend sellers of such drugs, and reduce crime in the assisted housing area.

SHERMAN YOUTH SPORTS ASSOCIATION: \$3,500

A program to provide sports equipment to children from low- and moderate-income households so that they can participate safely in activities offered by the Sherman Youth Sports Association.

TEXOMA FAMILY SHELTER, INC.: \$5,000

A program of activities that will provide emergency assistance to homeless individuals and families, who at one time, resided within the city limits of Sherman.
