ORDINANCE NO. 6470

An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Sherman, Texas, Repealing Ordinance No. 6377; Accepting and Approving a Service and Assessment Plan and a Phase #1 Assessment Roll for the Bel Air Village Public Improvement District; Making a Finding of Special Benefit to the Property in Phase #1 of the District; Levying Special Assessments Against Property Phase #1 of the District and Establishing a Lien on Such Property; Providing for Payment of the Assessments in Accordance with Chapter 372, Texas Local Government Code, as Amended; Providing for the Method of Assessment and the Payment of the Assessments, Providing Penalties and Interest on Delinquent Assessments, Providing for Severability, and Providing an Effective Date.
