- 2. **Name and location of reinvestment zone in which the property subject to the agreement is located**: City of Sherman Reinvestment Zone No. 10, comprised of 0.169 acres at 1013 South First Street in Sherman, Texas, as described and depicted in <u>Exhibit</u> A, attached hereto.
- 3. **General description of the nature of the improvements included in the agreement**: Construction by property owner/applicant of a single-family residence covering 1,536 square feet.
- 4. **Estimated cost of the improvements**: One hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000.00).
