How to Self Clean Your Grease Trap

1 Scoop Top Grease

 Let the grease trap cool down. Ice water may be drained from the sink to help the solids and grease settle. Scoop out all the grease and place into a plastic bag.



2 Remove Water

• Scoop out the water. Leave solids and sludge behind. Pour water into a sanitary sewer drain (i.e. floor drain or clean out).



3 Remove Solids and Sludge

 Scrape waste from all sides and bottom of the grease trap. Place in a plastic bag.



4 Clean All Parts

 Check and place all removable parts, baffles, and/or screens. Place waste/residue in a plastic bag.



5 Make Waste Solid

 Put cat litter, sawdust, coffee grounds, or other absorbent material into the bag and mix well.



6 Dispose

 Securely tie up the bag and dispose of into a trash can or dumpster.



7 Reassemble and Record

• Reassemble the trap. Tighten lid. Record cleaning on maintenance log sheet.
