- ➡ Cleaning Wipes of ANY KIND
(disinfectant, moist or baby wipes)
- ➡ Facial tissues, Cotton Balls, Swabs, Pads
- ➡ Diapers (cloth, disposable, “Flushable”)
- ➡ Toilet Bowl Scrub Pads
- ➡ Mop pads or wipes
- ➡ Medicine Patches



The past few years have seen the introduction of more and more disposable wipe and patch application products for a variety of hygiene, medical, household and commercial applications. Many of these products are labeled not only disposable, but also flushable. While marketed as convenience items, these products may potentially become a huge inconvenience because they may clog not only the sewer on private property, but also cause backup problems in Sherman’s public sewer system.
