

Picnic Pavilion Reservation Policies

The City of Sherman Parks and Recreation Department offers park pavilion rentals at specified parks. The reservation is for pavilion area only; the park itself is open to the public.

Reservation requests require the completion of a Facility Use Agreement which must be submitted so that approval shall be made two days prior to the requested date. Unreserved pavilions are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Please note:

- No open flame cooking is allowed except in provided cookeries.
- Users may provide their own grills, however, these should be placed in a safe area.
- The user is responsible for the conduct of their parties and their safety.
- The user is not allowed to charge any fee for the use of the facility without prior approval from Parks and Recreation.
- No vending or concessions are allowed without prior approval.
- Approval of use of pavilion does not constitute exclusive use of the area or equipment.
- Clean up area after use.
- No alcohol, rides, waterslides, pools, or fireworks of any kind are allowed.

Special Information

The use of "bounce houses" and other inflatable play equipment are allowed by permit only and require a \$25 fee plus a certificate of insurance. Any equipment installed without prior approval shall be immediately deflated and/or disconnected by the authorized City representative.

Events with entertainers, food vendors/caterers and/or more than 150 people may require additional fees and/or insurance and must have prior approval from the Parks and Recreation Department.

Why not have your next outdoor gathering at one of the many picnic pavilions within Sherman?

The Sherman Parks and Recreation Department oversees twenty-one park picnic areas located in most of the municipal parks. There are pavilions in different sizes to accommodate a small birthday party all the way up to a large company picnic. Each park provides its own unique setting and amenities.

Fairview Park is a very active park with playgrounds, softball fields, soccer fields, sand volleyball courts, walking trail, tennis courts and The Splash Family Aquatics Center.

Baker Park is a very serene nature park that has a hiking trail and a lake that is great for fishing.

Pecan Grove West Park is the newest park in Sherman. It has a fishing pier, walking trail, two state-of-the-art playgrounds, and an amphitheater. Call regarding amphitheater usage fees.

Pecan Grove East Park is a quieter park with a walking trail and a lake.

Hawn Park is home to the Sprayground which is usually open 8am-8pm everyday during the summer months. Hawn Park also has playground equipment, a skatepark, and walking trail.

Binkley Park, Ely Park, Hillcrest Park, Martin L. King Park, and Fielder Park are smaller neighborhood parks that provide a great setting for small family gatherings or birthday parties.

Center Street Park and Old Settlers Park are two sports-focused parks in Sherman. Center Street Park has a large pavilion, playground, and walking trail. Center Street also has two multi-purpose sport fields that must be reserved through the Parks and Recreation Office. Old Settlers Park has a very large pavilion that could accommodate well over 100 people and is also home to nine baseball/softball fields, walking trail, and playground.

As you can see there is a variety of setting in which you can host your next outdoor gathering.
